

What is Farsightedness?



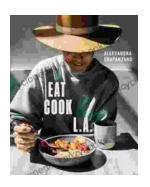
